SANT'AGATA: ARCHAEOLOGICAL PARK (ARCHAEOLOGICAL DOCUMENTATION CENTRE)

Pieve S. Agata - Scarperia e San Piero

The village consists of three huts: one belonging to Paleolithic hunters, one to Bronze Age farmers and herders (about 5,000 years ago), and one from the Iron Age (10th century BC). All the huts are furnished with "beds", a hearth, a weaving loom, weapons, tools, and many other objects used in everyday life at the time. Around the huts there are additional features, such as standing stones, poles with animal carcasses, and even an Iron Age pit grave.

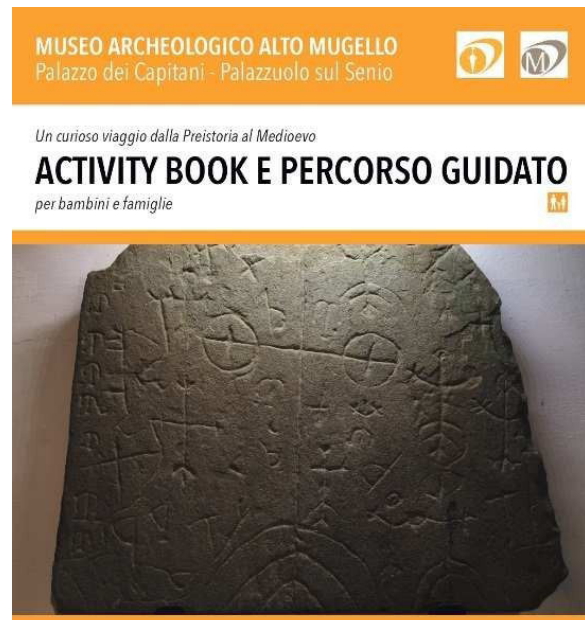

OASI del BELVEDERE

Covigliaio – FIRENZUOLA

The nature reserve covers approximately 650 hectares. Its vegetation consists of beech woods, oak forests and conifer plantations. This environment provides a natural habitat for the mouflon, introduced in 1975 and adopted as the symbol of the reserve, the Apennine newt and the southern crested newt, as well as the common buzzard, peregrine falcon, European honey buzzard, Eurasian eagle-owl and golden eagle. Roe deer, wild boar, foxes, martens, badgers and hares are also present. Of particular interest is the return of the Apennine wolf to the area.

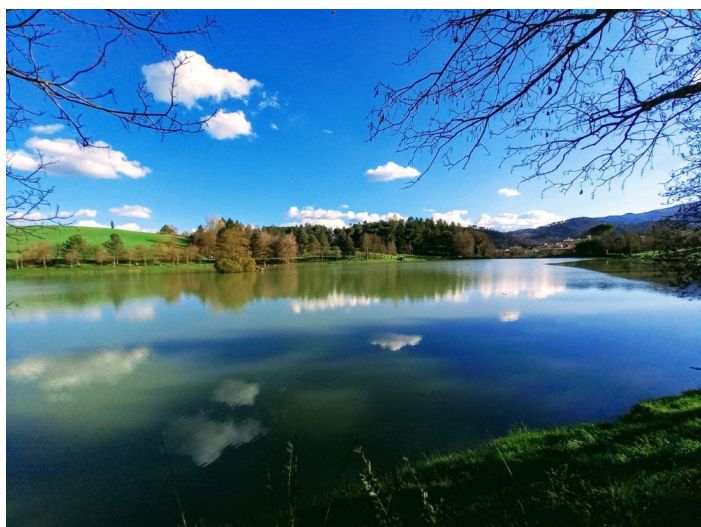
MONTELLERI'S LAKE

REFUGES, OPEN SHELTERS, AND EQUIPPED PICNIC AREAS in Mugello

In Mugello there is no shortage of equipped picnic areas, where in addition to tables and benches, some also feature fire pits and/or stone barbecues.

BORGO SAN LORENZO

CAPANNA MARCONE SHELTER

FREE SHELTER

A small equipped bivouac, always open, located along the ridge trail, not far from Prato all'Albero. It is surrounded by meadows and a striking high-altitude beech forest.

Here you can relax with your family and use the equipped area and fire pit for your picnics.

The only responsibility of visitors is to respect the surrounding environment and take good care of the shelter.



PRATO ALL'ALBERO

EQUIPPED AREA

A beautiful rest area just after the Colla di Casaglia pass, heading towards Palazzuolo sul Senio. There are many picnic spaces equipped for barbecues, as well as tables and benches, and plenty of greenery where you can relax and enjoy the cool air and the view. Many trails start from this area in various directions.

Some paths are wide and well maintained and can also be accessed with children in strollers, such as the one leading to Capanna Marcone.





LE PIANE SHELTER

FREE SHELTER

After passing Prato all'Albero, on the right, hidden in the greenery just 500 metres from the road, there is a beautiful place to relax with the family.

An area immersed in the forest where you will find an equipped picnic area and a fire pit for delicious barbecues in good company. Here, visitors' only responsibility is to respect the surrounding environment and take good care of the shelter.

CAPANNA SICUTERI SHELTER

FREE SHELTER

Reachable from Prato all'Albero, this is a charming place immersed in the forest. Here nature is the main feature.

Cool and breezy: an excellent spot to rest in complete silence, with an equipped area without a fire pit. Here, visitors' only responsibility is to respect the surrounding environment and take good care of the shelter



VALDICCIOLI REFUGE

The refuge is located within the Giogo–Casaglia Nature Reserve in Alto Mugello, in the Tuscan–Romagnolo Apennines. It features large open meadow areas and, being situated within the public forests of the Tuscany Region, it offers an unspoilt natural setting of great landscape and wildlife interest.

There is a ground fire pit available for any overnight stays. It remains accessible as an unmanaged bivouac for those hiking the trails of the Giogo–Casaglia Park.

FRASSINETA'S REFUGE

Nestled in the forest at 750 metres above sea level in the Mugello Apennines, at the centre of hiking trails within the protected area of the Giogo–Casaglia state forest complex. A refuge set in a beautiful beech and fir forest, waiting for your cool picnics and barbecues with friends.



CASA D'ERCI

EQUIPPED AREA

A place in Mugello where time seems to have stood still. It is an equipped area near an old farmhouse converted into a museum, which holds treasures from times long past. A place where you can breathe in and relive ancient traditions. Here you will find tables for your stops and picnic areas with a fire pit available.

DICOMANO

ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREA DI FRASCOLE

EQUIPPED AREA

In the Frascole area, in addition to the important archaeological site dating back to the Etruscan period, which can be visited by families, school groups, and scholars, there are wooden tables and benches outside the site.



FIRENZUOLA



LA SERRA REFUGE

Reachable from Moscheta and Prato all'Albero, this refuge is located in the heart of the Apennines. It has an excellent position and facilities, and is a great starting point for many trekking routes. There is an outdoor shelter for eating outside, a barbecue area, and both indoor and outdoor running water at the spring. A wonderful place to experience life in close contact with nature.

PASSO DEL GIOGO

EQUIPPED AREA

At the height of the Hotel Restaurant Il Giogo, there is a pleasant place where you can fully immerse yourself in the nature and forests of Alto Mugello. From here, many trails start, which you can also explore together with your family.

You will also find an equipped picnic area with tables and benches.



AREA CAMPING MOSCHETA

EQUIPPED AREA

In the Moscheta area, there is a site immersed in the greenery of the Tuscan–Emilian Apennine forests. It also features picnic tables and barbecues. The area is perfect for long walks along marked trails.

CA' DEL TOPO SHELTER

FREE SHELTER

The Cà del Topo Bivouac is located in the municipality of Palazzuolo sul Senio, in the Tuscan–Romagnolo Apennines, at about 840 metres above sea level. It is a hiking structure immersed in the woods near the springs of the Rio Rovigo. It features a small kitchenette and 4 beds for overnight stays, as well as an outdoor fire pit. It is an ideal support point for trekking and crossings in Alto Mugello. The surrounding environment is characterised by beech forests, scenic trails, and unspoilt nature.

PIEDIMONTE

FREE SHELTER

At the exit of Palazzuolo sul Senio, heading towards Passo della Sambuca, you will find the sign on the right. Follow the unpaved road, which leads to a small parking area and an equipped picnic area along the river. From here, several trails start, making it a highly recommended spot for a picnic and a walk with children. Here, visitors' only responsibility is to respect the surrounding environment and take good care of the shelter.



CA' DI CICCIO SHELTER

FREE SHELTER

Accessible only on foot from the parking area near Passo della Sambuca, this place is set in greenery and tranquility and enjoys a commanding position over the valley with a spectacular view.

Here you will find an outdoor table with a barbecue area, perfect for spending a day surrounded by nature.

Here, visitors' only responsibility is to respect the surrounding environment and take good care of the shelter

CANNOVA and I DIACCI REFUGES

Places immersed in the nature of Mugello, where several trails converge and lead into the forest or to the Rovigo stream. A wonderful spot where you can spend a day in total relaxation. Picnic tables are available for sharing a meal outdoors.

LA PINETA DI SCARPERIA

EQUIPPED AREA

The pine forest is about 2 km from the historic centre and can be reached by car or via a tree-lined pedestrian path. It is a place suitable for walks, sports, and recreational activities. The equipped area covers approximately 16 hectares and includes a range of services such as nearby car parking, benches and picnic tables, drinking water fountains, and public restrooms. Within the area, there are several pedestrian paths that wind through the vegetation.

AREA FONTE FREDDA

EQUIPPED AREA

A beautiful place to stop and rest after a walk, or to immerse yourself in nature and enjoy a moment of silence for meditation.

Equipped picnic area with fire pits available for your barbecues. The access road requires a 4x4 vehicle.



SAN GODENZO



AREA FIERA DEI POGGI AL CASTAGNO D'ANDREA

EQUIPPED AREA

It is the ideal base for excursions to Falterona, Falco, and Monte Acuto. The surrounding landscape is characterised by extensive and picturesque “marronete”, chestnut groves of centuries-old cultivated trees used for the production of chestnuts.

Here you will find an equipped area with 6–7 shaded tables and space for barbecues.

AREA CENTRO VISITE PARCO DELLE FORESTE CASENTINESI

EQUIPPED AREAS

Within the Park area there are numerous rest areas equipped with benches and tables, and often also barbecues, available to visitors of the protected area. Responsible and proper use of these areas is required, also to facilitate their maintenance and ensure continued access. There are also specific areas designated for camper parking, in some cases equipped with waste disposal facilities (camper service areas).



It is recommended to consult the regulations on the use of open fires and camping activities within the Park.



ECOTOURISM TRAILS



In Mugello there are four ecotourism routes:

- 1- Borgo San Lorenzo–Ponte a Vicchio: 9 km
 - 2- Borgo San Lorenzo–Larciano: 2.6 Km
 - 3- Dicomano–Contea: 1 km
 - 4- San Piero–Scarperia: 4.6 km
