WHY VISIT PALAZZUOLO?

Palazzuolo lies in the Florentine province, but its culture and customs are closer to those of neighbouring Romagna. Nestled on a valley and surrounded by mountains, this town is a harmonious place, where time flows together with generous nature in a setting of unspoilt beauty. The days pass slowly between sporting activities and walks, typical smells and flavours, and with old knowledge handed down and told to those who have the patience to listen.

HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

The history of this territory, which today has a little over one thousand inhabitants, almost uninterrupted dates back to the upper Palaeolithic. In the late Middle Ages, it was a fief of both the Pagans and of the Ubaldini, until Maghinardo Pagani from Suinana died and it passed solely to the dominion of the Ubaldini. In 1373, it was possessed by the Florentine Republic and its fate followed. The important past is proven by the remains of numerous castles, villages with parish churches and ancient rural houses. Certainly, many pages of its history have been influenced by the town's relationship with nature and the lifestyle to which it is still closely linked.
