## HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

The history of this territory, which today has a little over one thousand inhabitants, almost uninterruptedly dates back to the upper Palaeolithic. In the late Middle Ages, it was a fief of both the Pagans and of the Ubaldini, until Maghinardo Pagani from Suinana died and it passed solely to the dominion of the Ubaldini. In 1373, it was possessed by the Florentine Republic and its fate followed. The important past is proven by the remains of numerous castles, villages with parish churches and ancient rural houses.
